

Nominations Open: CCSU-AAUP Officers & Council Representatives

Nominations are now open for a full slate of officers including President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, two delegates-at-large and four CCSU-AAUP chapter representatives to the CSU-AAUP Council. The term of office is two years beginning May 1 for officers, including delegates-at-large, and June 1 for Council Representatives. Nominations will close at 3:00 p.m. March 15, 2013.

Who is eligible to run? Any CCSU-AAUP member is eligible to nominate and/or be nominated for any position(s). All persons so nominated shall be placed on the ballot.

Officer Responsibilities: Pursuant to the CCSU-AAUP Constitution, the Executive Committee, consisting of the Officers, immediate past President, Council Representatives including the alternate and two delegates-at-large shall act on behalf of the membership in carrying out the purposes of the organization. CCSU-AAUP Executive Committee meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month at noon.

What Is the Council? The CSU-AAUP Council is the governing body of the four campus CSU-AAUP bargaining unit. According to the CSU-AAUP Constitution, the Council selects and instructs the bargaining team, authorizes the officers to invoke binding arbitration, recommends the dues rate to the membership, establishes committees, publishes reports, creates and adopts the organizational budget and forms and maintains contact and coalitions with other organizations. How many representatives does CCSU-AAUP have on the CSU-AAUP Council? Representation to the Council is proportional. CCSU-AAUP currently has 8 representatives, to the Council, one alternate and the Chapter President.

What are the duties of a Council Representative? The duties of a council representative include attendance at two monthly meetings at which decisions are made. CSU-AAUP Council Meetings are traditionally held on the 3rd Thursday of the month (7:00-10:00pm) on the CCSU campus. The CCSU-AAUP Executive Committee meetings are held on the second Wednesday of the month at noon in the Mountain Laurel Room in Memorial Hall. CSU-AAUP Council Representatives from CCSU are expected to attend all regularly scheduled meetings.

How would I learn what I need to know to carry out my responsibilities? Council Representatives are eligible and encouraged to participate in several AAUP trainings, including national meetings, regional meetings and AAUP summer institutes to enhance their abilities to carry out their responsibilities.

Procedure: Please use the form on the reverse of this announcement to nominate yourself or any other member. Please PRINT your name in the space marked "NOMINATOR" and the name of the person(s) you wish to nominate in the space(s) marked "NOMINEE". You must obtain the signature of the individual(s) you are nominating indicating: 1) they are members of AAUP and 2) they would be willing and able to serve, if elected. All nominees will be asked to submit a statement for the ballot.
